

14 Allergens

Coming to a food label near you



The way allergens are labelled on prepacked foods is changing because of new regulations. The Food Information Regulation, which comes into force in December 2014, introduces a requirement that food businesses must provide information about the allergenic ingredients used in any food they sell or provide.

There are 14 major allergens which need to be mentioned either on a label or through provided information such as verbal when they are served as ingredients in a food. Here are the allergens, and some examples of where they can be found:

1 Celery

This includes celery stalks, leaves, seeds and the root called celeriac. You can find celery in soups, stews, salads, some meat products, soups and stock cubes.

2 Cereals containing gluten

Wheat, barley, rye and oats are the main sources of gluten. It is found in bread, pasta, cereals, biscuits, cakes, pastries, crisps, soups, soups, soups and soups.

3 Crustaceans

Crabs, lobsters, prawns and shrimps are crustaceans. They are often used in fish and seafood dishes, soups, stews, soups, soups and soups.

4 Eggs

Eggs are often found in cakes, some meat products, soups, soups, soups, soups, soups, soups and soups.

5 Fish





**14 Allergens**  
Coming to a food label near you

The way allergens are labelled on prepacked foods is changing because of new regulations. There are 14 major allergens which need to be mentioned either on a label or through provided information such as menus or when they are used as ingredients in a food. Here are the allergens, and some examples of how they can be found:

- 1 Celery**  
This includes celery stalks, leaves, seeds and the root stalk (celery). You can find celery in soups, stews, salads, some meat products, soups and some cakes.
- 2 Cereals containing gluten**  
Wheat, spelt and other grains (barley, rye, oats) and cereals made from them. Cereals containing gluten can be found in bread, pasta, cereal, muesli, breakfast cereals, some meat products, some soups, some drinks and some cakes.
- 3 Crustaceans**  
Crabs, lobster, prawns and crabs are crustaceans. Shrimp, prawns, other shellfish and other crustaceans are also crustaceans. They can be found in soups, stews, salads, some meat products, some soups, some drinks and some cakes.
- 4 Eggs**  
Eggs are found in cakes, some meat products, some soups, some drinks and some cakes.
- 5 Fish**  
This includes fish, including fish, salmon, trout, cod, haddock, plaice, sole, etc.
- 6 Lupin**  
Lupin is a bean. It is also found in flour. It is found in some soups, stews, salads, some meat products, some soups, some drinks and some cakes.
- 7 Milk**  
Milk is a common ingredient in food. It is found in many products, including milk, cream, butter, cheese, yoghurt, ice cream, etc.
- 8 Molluscs**  
Molluscs include snails, slugs, scallops and mussels. They can be found in soups, stews, salads, some meat products, some soups, some drinks and some cakes.
- 9 Mustard**  
Mustard is a common ingredient in food. It is found in many products, including mustard, ketchup, mayonnaise, etc.
- 10 Nuts**  
Nuts include almonds, hazelnuts, walnuts, etc. They can be found in cakes, bread, pasta, cereal, muesli, breakfast cereals, some meat products, some soups, some drinks and some cakes.
- 11 Peanuts**  
Peanuts are a type of legume. They can be found in cakes, bread, pasta, cereal, muesli, breakfast cereals, some meat products, some soups, some drinks and some cakes.
- 12 Sesame seeds**  
Sesame seeds are found in many products, including sesame oil, tahini, etc.
- 13 Soya**  
Soya is a type of legume. It is found in many products, including soya sauce, tofu, etc.
- 14 Sulphur dioxide (sometimes known as sulphites)**  
Sulphur dioxide is a preservative. It is found in many products, including wine, etc.





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
